Objective: To identify several significant holidays represented by the students in your classes and in Northwest

Arkansas in order to create a yearly calendar with appropriate illustrations that reflect Banks' ten

variables of Multicultural identity.

Directions: Find out what ethnicities are represented in your school in the third rotation (ALL ethnicities). Ask

students to identify several celebrations unique to his/her culture.
