Homework Assignment One: Diamond Poem

<u>Goal:</u> to practice using a beginning level activity for Standard 1.3 that can be used in one of your internship classes.

<u>**Objective:**</u> Students will be able to demonstrate knowledge of descriptive vocabulary by creating a diamond poem.
